Activities expected to be undertaken by the college cell are as follows:


- a. Talk sessions by 4 startups / industrialist in a semester (one per month).

- f. Information on opportunities on Startups innovations will be shared periodically with such cells.

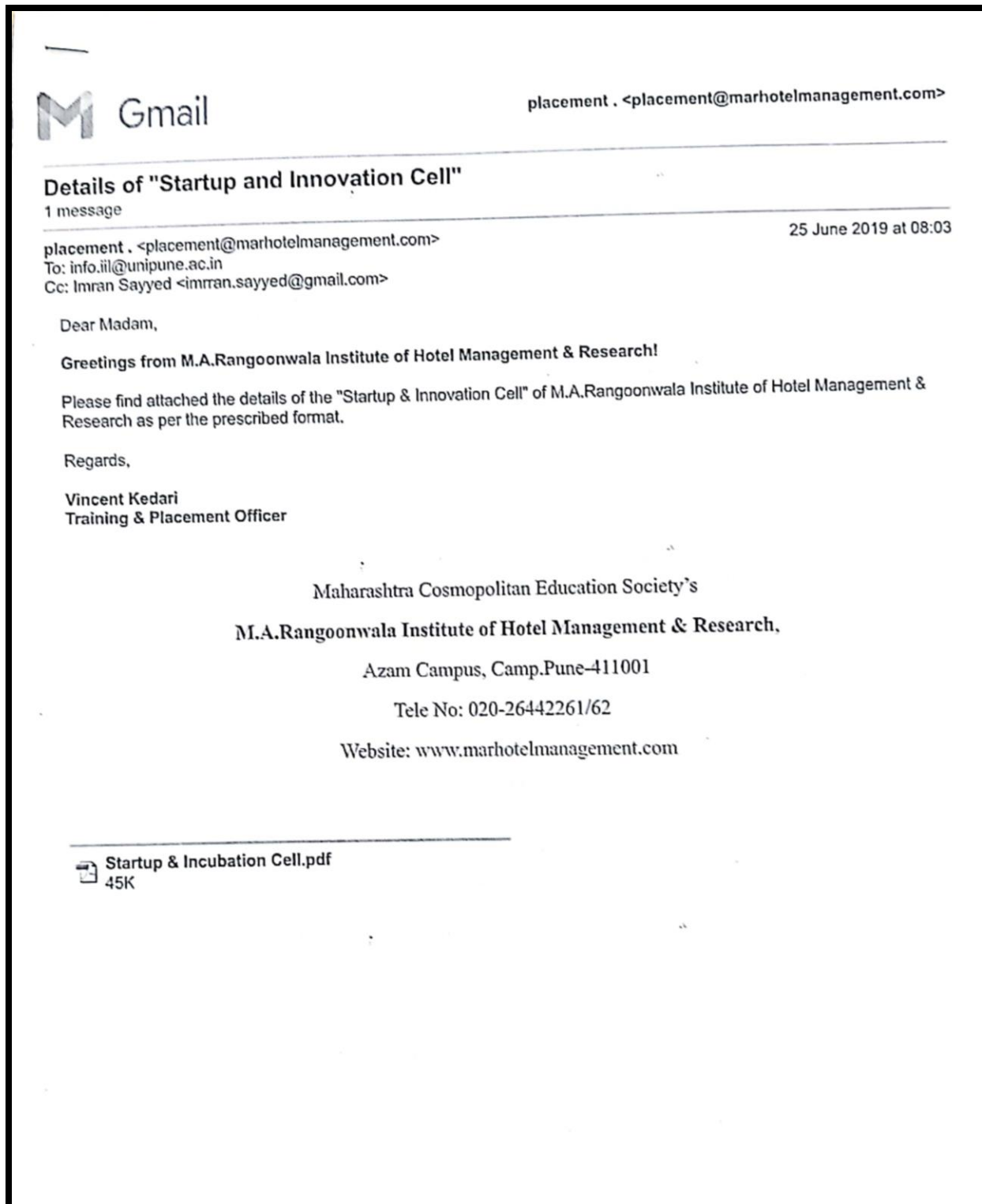

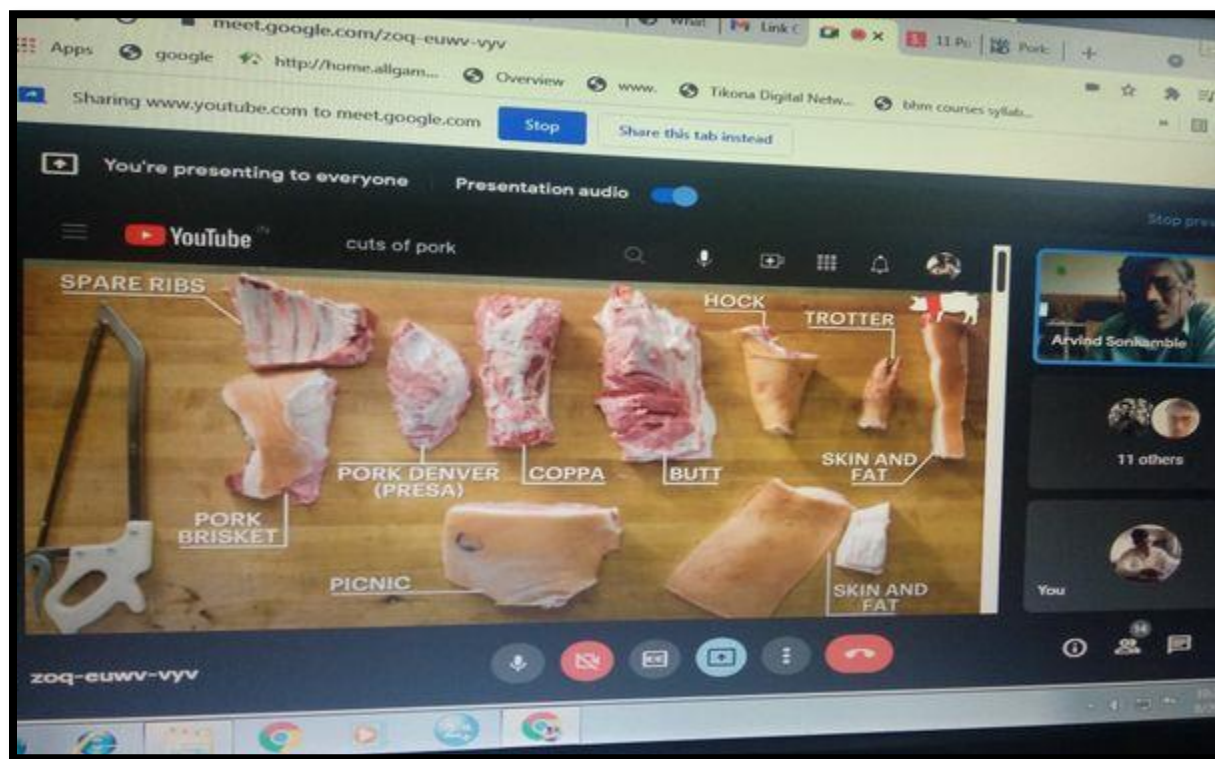
