Social Justice and Special Assistance

Eligibility

- 1) The parents/Guardian annual income shall be less than or equal to Rs. 2,50,000.
- 2) Student category shall belong to Scheduled caste or Navboudha.
- 3) Student shall belong to resident of Maharashtra.
- 4) Student should be passes SSC/equivalent Matric.
- 5) Failure: if student fail first time then should avail Exam fees & maintenance allowance. If fails second time in same class then he/she will not get any allowance and after two drops he will pass and go to next class then he will be eligible.
- 6) In case of student studying out of Maharashtra then same rules are applicable as per GOI.
- 7) Only 2 professional Courses are allowed.

- The parents / Guardian annual income above Rs. 250000.to unlimited.
- Student category should be Scheduled caste or Neo bouddhist.
- Student should be resident of Maharashtra.
- Student should be passes SSC/equivalent Matric.
- Institute should be located in Maharashtra & shall be government recognized.
- For Professional Courses student should admit through CAP round only.
- Only 1 Failure is allowed in whole curriculum.

Post Matric- State Government scholarship for minority students studying in Arts, Commerce, Science, Law, and Education Courses (part-2).

Eligibility

(As Per GR Dated 14.10.2011)

1. Graduation and post-graduation can apply (arts/commerce/science/Law/Education).
2. Domicile of Maharashtra.
3. Income should be up to Rs.8 lakhs.
4. Only 2000 applicants will be provided quota (freshers).
5. Maharashtrian Students studying Out of Maharashtra cannot apply for this scheme.

- 4) 12th year mark sheet.

Overview

This scheme is belongs to Muslim, Buddha, Christian, Jain ,Sikh , Parsi , Jews religion.

Eligibility

- For students who had taken admission from MBBS ,BDS ,BAMS ,BHMS ,BUMS, BPTH ,BOTH ,BASLP ,BP&O ,BSc Nursing ,MSc Nursing ,BPMT,OPHTHALMIC ASST.,OPTOMETRY,PB BSc Nursing and courses affiliated to Maharashtra university of health science, Nashik..
- Family's Annual Income less than equal to 8,00,000..
- Admission to the course should be through CET/competitive exam/HSC marks obtained.
- 30%scholarship is reserved for girls. First list of 70% students (combined) is prepared and after that 30% girls scholarship will be selected which are not included in 70% list.
- The person should be Domicile of Maharashtra.
- If targeted amount of scholarship for particular minority community is not achieved then other minority community student's scholarship can be included in it.
- Also applicable for candidate studying outside Maharashtra, but he/she must be a domicile of Maharashtra/resident of Maharashtra since 15years.

If candidate is studying outside Maharashtra the following documents need to be submitted:

- Letter from concerned council/Authority stating the institute is recognized
- Copy of FRA
- Bonafide for current academic year

5. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Double form sent by applicant will be rejected.
6. Only full time Government recognized professional course conducted by a statutory body such as University, Board, Director of Technical Education, AICTE etc. will be considered. Institutions and courses should be recognized and affiliated to establish Universities/Government.
7. Our representative(s) will survey the authenticity of application and if any information provided is found suppressed/false or improper then application form will be rejected and application will not be accepted in future.
8. NCT has the right to reclaim the help granted, if the information is found incorrect or false even after fund disbursement.
9. Decision of our committee regarding acceptance or rejection of application will remain final and no correspondence or clarification will be provided.
10. The student will be given scholarship on the basis of Aptitude, Intelligence quotient (IQ), Interest, Personality test also known as psychometric test results.
11. Please note that Aptitude, intelligence Quotient (IQ), Interest, Personality test is to guide the student for the best career options. Aptitude testing does not GUARANTEE of SCHOLARSHIP.

12. Also note that this form will not be considered unless accompanied by the attested photo copy's (Xerox copies) of the document mentioned, if the required original to be produced during field visit/interview. In collaboration with Exclusively for Std XI & XII Sponsored by World Memon Organisation (WMO).

13. Applications of such students shall not be considered who intends to/are pursuing their degree courses from cities other than their hometown when such course can be pursued in their home city. They are not entitled for any help from the trust.

14. If a scholar gives up the selected course of study before its completion, or change the course of study, is expelled from the institution on disciplinary or academic grounds, the scholarship will be cancelled.

15. Organization believes that after the basic professional (i.e. Engineering/Medical) degree a person is capable of earning very decent amount. Hence he/she is not eligible to receive organization scholarship; however there are some exceptional cases where if the student is found super meritorious and found eligible through organization criteria's such students are encouraged for further studies.

3 Attested copies of past three annual examination mark sheet/result copies for school level and for college level SSC and HSC (compulsory for new student).

4 Proof of address first & last page of Ration card or Telephone bill or Voting Identity card or Leave & License agreement or Rent receipt/Bill or Aadhaar card.

5 Latest Electricity bill.

6 Divorce certificate/Divorce deed in case of divorcee, Death certificate of husband in case of widow is compulsory. Medical certificate if husband medically ill e.g. dialysis, heart problem, paralysis, cancer or any other threatening diseases.

7 Proof of Income - Salary certificate or Govt. approved Income certificate or Pay Slip or Certificate from family doctor or Local medical social worker (MSW) or Medical officers of primary health centre (PHC) or Community health centre (CHC) regarding the family income (Compulsoryapplicable according to their nature of work).

8 Letter from School/College/Institute with break-up of fees (in original).

9 Proof of admission/Selection in course for which scholarship is applied for/Bonafied certificates.

10 Copies of certificates of academic, co-curricular & extracurricular activities.

11 Copy of bank pass book – First page (name, bank a/c no. & address details).

Non- Government Sponsorship

Rangoonwala Foundation (India) Trust:

An Agreement was made between Rangoonwala Foundation (India) Trust (RF(I)T) with its head office at 85 Atlanta, Nariman Point, Mumbai- 400021 of the first part and Haji Gulam Mohommed Azam Education Trust, Pune (HGMAET) and Maharashtra Cosmopolitan Education Society (MCES), Pune both at address 2390, KB Hidayatullah Rd, Azam Campus, Pune – 411014 of the second part As per the special conditions mentioned in the agreement The MCES and HGMAET agree to admit six student applicants recommended by RF(I)T, through the RF(I)T duly authorized representative: in the degree course at the start of every academic year, irrespective of their gender, caste, race, religion or otherwise. The RF(I)T's recommended applicants will pay an annual all inclusive course fee of INR 15,000 per year. The HGMAET/MCES are bound not to raise any objections on the ground of gender, caste, race, religion or otherwise and in terms of fee to be paid in respect of the aforesaid recommended applications.

Since 2004, RF(I)T has been supporting needy students from Mumbai who have secured admissions to professional colleges on merit, but are unable to pay for education and related costs.

We follow a system of pre-screening, base interview and document check to decide if a form is to be issued. The form has components for the socio-economic profile of the family, educational record since SSC or equivalent and competitive entrance exams, proof of admission and fee structure, collective responsibility at the applicant's level in the form of two references and two recommenders.

This is followed by a home visit and cross referencing. Based on the above, a final interview is conducted to decide the nature and amount of assistance.

Criteria for Scholarship Applicants:

- S.C., H.S.C. and CET Percentage should be a minimum of 70%.

- Institutions and courses should be recognized and affiliated to established Universities / have Government recognition.
- Annual fees should be more than Rs.20,000.
- Courses eligible for scholarship should be professional Degree courses. Diplomas will be considered only for courses where degree courses are not available or in the case of post graduate Diplomas.
- Social work education (BSW and MSW) and students with disabilities form a separate category of support.
- RF(I)T's contribution goes directly to the Educational Institution.
- In borderline cases or change of medium from vernacular to English SSC+ HSC+CET average of 70% is considered.
- Students applying in the second year or later will have to fulfill the above criteria and should not have ATKTs in any subject.
- Foreign study is not supported.
